| | <i>Cirsium horridulum</i> | Food | Tender, white hearts eaten raw. | Yellow Thistle |
| | <i>Lagenaria siceraria</i> | Cooking tool | Used for water dippers, cups, and bowls. | Bottle Gourd |
| | <i>Lagenaria siceraria</i> | Musical Instrument | Used for drums and rattles. | Bottle Gourd |
| | <i>Myrica cerifera</i> | Lighting | Berries boiled and wax used to make candles. | Southern Bayberry |
| | <i>Myrica heterophylla</i> | Lighting | Berries boiled and wax used to make candles. | Evergreen Bayberry |
| | <i>Quercus virginiana</i> | Dye | Red color. Roots and bark boiled to make a red basket dye. | Live Oak |
| | <i>Rumex salicifolius</i> | Dye | Roots used to make a dye for cane and palmetto splints in baskets. | Mexican Dock |
| | <i>Sabal minor</i> | Food | Bread & Cake. Fresh root slices baked and eaten as bread. | Dwarf Palmetto |
| | <i>Sambucus canadensis</i> | Hunting/Fishing item | Stalks formerly used for blowguns. | American Elder |
| | <i>Sambucus cerulea</i> | Hunting/Fishing item | Stalks formerly used for blowguns. | Blue Elderberry |
| | <i>Scirpus species</i> | Fiber | Brushes & Brooms | Rat Grass |
| | <i>Smilax bona-nox</i> | Food | Bread & Cake. Tuberous roots dried, ground into flour, and used to make bread. | Saw Greenbrier |
| | <i>Smilax laurifolia</i> | Food | Bread & Cake. Tuberous roots dried, ground into flour, and used to make bread. | Laurel Greenbrier |
| | <i>Sonchus oleraceus</i> | Food | Fodder (feed for livestock). Plants used for hog feed. | Common Sowthistle |
| | <i>Tillandsia usneoides</i> | Fiber | Cordage (rope). Dried fibers twisted and used for cordage. | Spanish Moss |
| | <i>Tillandsia usneoides</i> | Fiber | Mats, Rugs, Bedding. Dried fibers twisted and used to make floor mats. | Spanish Moss |
